### A Letter from Revd Andrew Tuck

Dear Friends,

Whatever your political opinions, it is almost certain that you will have strong views on the NHS. This year is the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Aneurin Bevan's great vision for providing health care free at the point of delivery to every resident in the UK whatever their income.

The NHS is now under huge pressure, with more and more resources needed to meet the needs of its ageing population and increasing expectations in its services. Recruiting doctors and nurses is becoming increasingly difficult, social service budgets have been drastically cut and all this adds incredible pressure on the health service.

Last weekend I spent over five hours at Basingstoke Hospital A&E department – imagine the scene; all the staff were under pressure and being Saturday evening all human life was there. Although it was long wait, everyone was eventually seen and treated, no one was turned away because they couldn't afford it or because they had an addiction problem or a pre-existing condition. It reminded me of Jesus' ministry; before healing somebody, Jesus never asked about their medical history.

In the next few months we expect that our MP Jeremy Hunt will unveil his plans for the future funding of the NHS. Keeping that vision of free health care at the point of delivery for each and every member of the community is a principle that was visionary in 1947; let us hope that we do not lose that vision in the years to come.
